Department of Labour Household Labour Force Survey results for the March 2010 quarter

The March quarter results were surprising and out of line with what Statistics New Zealand and commentators were expecting. The results show that the unemployment rate has fallen to 6.0% and employment has increased 1.0%. The fall in unemployment is the largest quarterly fall since the survey began in 1986. Businesses have started to employ workers again.

Employment increased by 22,000 (1.0%), following a 0.1% increase in the December 2009 quarter. The rise in December was the first increase in employment since the end of 2008.
